ARRIVAL INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS

Head North on Rt. 31. IL 31 becomes US 12W towards Lake Geneva (crossing into Wisconsin). Take US 12W into Fort Atkinson, turn right on 3rd Street & follow the signs to Rt. 26. Take Rt. 26 North. At Rosendale, take Rt. 23 West (turn left) through Ripon. The conference center entrance is approximately 6 miles from Ripon, on your left. Watch for posted signs for Lawsonia Golf Course and Green Lake Conference Center.

OR

Take Rt. 14 North to Janesville to 190/94, past Madison to 78/51 North. Take Hwy 23 East, through Montello and Princeton. The conference center is 6 miles from Princeton on your right. Watch for posted signs for Lawsonia Golf Course and Green Lake Conference Center.

Set your GPS for the Conference Center address above. Happy & safe driving!

Linens (sheets, pillow & pillowcase, one blanket and a set of towels) are supplied for each person (EXCEPT CAMPERS). Extra blankets are in the closet. Stores are open in Green Lake (three miles) as well as the Country Store on the grounds for bread, milk and similar things (at greater prices, of course).

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES

- If possible, arrive in the daylight. Please call 224-305-5166 if you will be arriving after 11PM.
- Bring a variety of clothing. It can vary from hot to cold.
- Remember our all-church catered dinner at the beach, Saturday at 5:30PM. It's FREE! And don't forget to bring your camp chairs or blankets; there will be no tables/chairs available.
- Bring all your own food. Basic groceries are available on the grounds at the Padelford Country Store. Full grocery stores are located in Green Lake, Princeton and Ripon (a 15-20 min drive). All houses and cabins have kitchens, but Kern Lodge does not. The lodge has a small refrigerator in the main lounge. Bringing a cooler for your room is recommended.
- Please, NO PETS are allowed for those staying in a cabin, house or hotel. Campers may bring pets if they follow the rule set by Green Lake: "Pets must be leashed at all times and must never be left at your site unattended."

OCCUPANCY LIMITS ARE STRICTLY ADHERED TO BECAUSE OF FIRE LAWS. It is mandatory that we adhere to them, and it is a good witness to those at the Green Lake Conference Center. Please note that babies are a part of that count. Cribs are for use in place of a bunk bed, not in addition to it.

KERN LODGE GUEST LETTER

Hello to all Kern Lodge & Roger Williams Inn Dwellers! Following you will find some information for Green Lake that relates directly to you.

The rooms do not contain convenience items. You will need to bring all of your personal items; e.g., shampoo, soap, hair dryer, etc.

Please remember: there is no cooking allowed in the onsite hotels! There is, however, a microwave in the lounge for warming up previously-prepared food. Coffee is available in the lounge (as well as a vending machine), or you can bring your own coffee maker.

There is a restaurant located in the Kraft Centre. If you wish to eat a meal in the Bauer Dining Room, you will need to purchase a meal ticket at the front desk. Please note that a limited number of tickets are available. The hours & prices are:

A WORD TO PARENTS
