**Gal 4:4** But when the fullness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law, 5 so that He might redeem those who were under the Law, that we might the adoption receive as sons. 6 Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" 7 Therefore you are no longer a slave, but a son; and if a son, then an heir through God.

**Ps 86:5** For You, Lord, are good, and ready to forgive, And abundant in lovingkindness to all who call upon You...15 But You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness and truth.

**Micah 7:18** Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. (NIV)

You are Fully God and Fully Man, my Mediator and the one who Reconciled me to God. You are the Conquering King and Humble Servant, the Lion and the Lamb. You are my Sacrifice (taking away all my sin) and my Sanctification (making me like You). You are my Strength and my Joy, my Peace and my Glory. You are my Provider and my Provision. You are my Inheritance and everything I need. You are my Victory and my Life, my Redeemer and my Redemption, my Liberator and my Deliverer. You are my Prince of Peace, my Beloved Bridegroom and the Lover of my soul. You are my Way, my Truth and my Life, the Author and Finisher of my faith, the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End. You are my Everything and my All and All.

Isa 7:14 a virgin will be with child and bear a son, and she will call His name Immanuel (God with us).

**Isa 9:6-7** For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. 7 There will be no end to the increase of His government or of peace

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things came into being by Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men...9 There was the true light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man. 10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him...14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth. 18 No man has seen God at any time; the only begotten God, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained Him.

**Col 2:9** For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form, 10 and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority;

**Titus 2:13** looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus **Heb 1:1** God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, 2 in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. 3 And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power.

Rev 1:8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."



## Read a verse and then pray it back to God in first person declaring who He is and thanking Him for who He is.

The Holy Spirit is a Person and is fully God. He is to be worshipped with the Father and the Son. He regenerates, indwells and seals believers for the day of redemption. He guides believers into all truth, sanctifies and bears the fruit of Christ-like character in believers. Scripture exhorts believers to be continually filled with the Holy Spirit, to be led by the Holy Spirit and to walk in fellowship with Him. The Holy Spirit desires to empower and anoint believers for godly living, ministry and witness.

**John 7:37** Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. 38 "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being will flow rivers of living water." 39 But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**John 3:34** God...gives the Spirit without measure.

**John 14:16** "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; 17 that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you. (The Greek word for Helper or Comforter is parakletos, clete meaning "called" and para meaning "along with." The Holy Spirit as Paraclete is "One who is called to walk alongside you," or "One who is called to your aid.")...26 "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

Acts 1:8 but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

**John 16:12** "I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear {them} now. 13 "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. 14 "He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you. 15 "All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you.

**Luke 11:13** "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?"

**Rom 8:14** For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. 15 For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God,

**2 Cor 1:22** [God] sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge. (Pledge" in this verse refers to the Holy Spirit whom God gave to us as a guarantee of our full inheritance and redemption. It is the Greek word arrabon, which is an engagement ring. The Person of the Holy Spirit was given to us by God like an engagement ring in hope of the complete union of Christ and His Bride.)

**Judges 6:34** the Spirit of the LORD came upon Gideon (The phrase "the Spirit of the Lord came upon Gideon" literally means, "the Spirit of God clothed Himself with Gideon."

**Luke 24:49** "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high." The Holy Spirit clothes Himself with you!)
